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Overview

The Aga Khan High School, Kampala is a private, non-profit, non-denominational, co-educational, day school for students in Grades 7–12. It is part of the Aga Khan Education Services (AKES), one of the largest pre-tertiary education networks across East Africa, the Middle East and South and Central Asia, with a vast majority of its schools located in rural and remote communities where access to quality education is limited. AKES is part of the Aga Khan Schools (AKS), an agency within the Aga Khan Development Network. AKS comprises a network of 200 schools, more than 100 non-formal education programme centres and eight hostels, serving almost 110,000 students from the age of 18 months to adulthood each year across 12 countries.

Established in 1905, AKES is built on over a century of leadership in education, equipping learners with the knowledge, skills, attitudes and values to thrive in a complex and dynamic world. The Aga Khan High School, Kampala contributes to this legacy by providing quality education for its students, along with opportunities for growth inside and outside the classroom.

Curriculum

The Aga Khan High School, Kampala is an IB World School offering the Diploma Programme (DP). The International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE), as well as the national curriculum, or the Uganda Certificate of Secondary Education (UCE) and the Uganda Advanced Certificate in Secondary Education (UACE), are also available for students.

Graduation requirements

- 6 subjects: 3 at Higher Level (HL) and 3 at Standard Level (SL)
- Theory of knowledge (TOK)
- 4,000-word extended essay (EE) on a student-chosen topic
- Creativity, activity, service (CAS): Extensive participation in community-based service projects

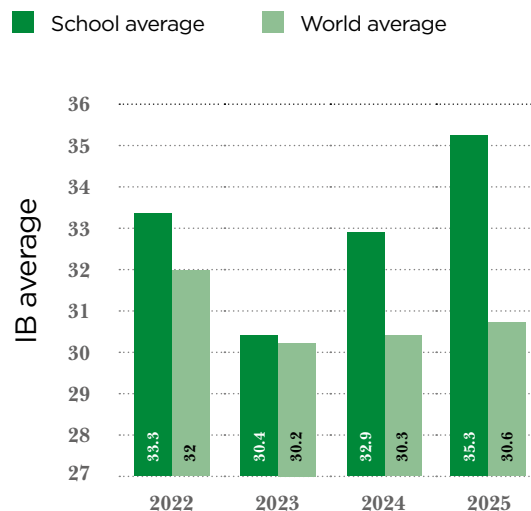
Unique service initiatives

At the Aga Khan High School, Kampala, IB DP students collaborate with local organisations on a variety of initiatives for their CAS portfolio, which helps them develop their leadership and interpersonal skills. During the 2024–2025 academic year, the students led various service initiatives relating to sports training, environmental sustainability and music. They also volunteered at the Uganda SPCA, an animal hospital.

The Aga Khan High School, Kampala does not rank its students. However, achievement is awarded with an honour roll. Additionally, the Student of the Year Award is awarded to a graduating student who exhibits exemplary holistic development over the course of the DP and personifies the IB learner profile. Nineteen classes have graduated and have outperformed the IB world average on the DP exams. 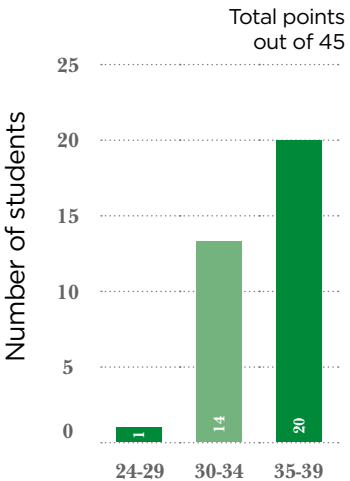

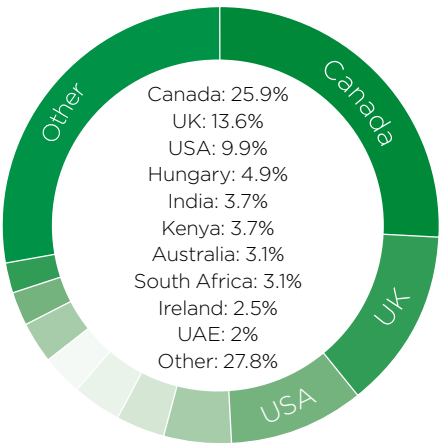
