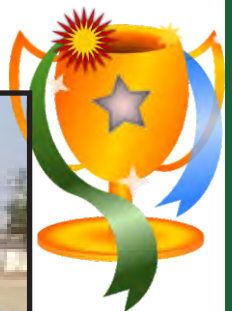

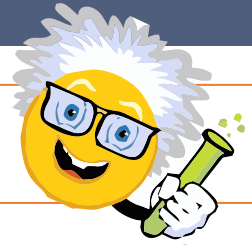

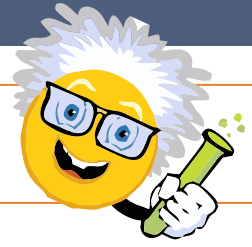
Platinum Jubilee High School hosts the first inter-school science extravaganza ISARD 2016
